Abbreviations:

BB = Bodlondeb buoy (green buoy on the seaward side of Bodlondeb point)

CC = Conwy cob buoy (pinkish buoy off the Cob labelled "Race 1")

P = Perch

T = Tunnel mark (yellow buoy off the seaward end of the tunnel bund Deganwy side of the river)

WS = West shore mark (yellow buoy off the West Shore cafe)

SL = Starting Line

FLc = Finishing Line

Note that the North Deep marks have been moved to the new channel (2016).

Radio channel for Dayboats/CODs - 69

ChCo means 'Pass between all paired channel buoys and leave all other channel marks on the correct side according to direction of travel (ie into or out of the estuary)'.
